#### Teacher Certification Program Definition

If the student is enrolled in a required teacher certification program, he/she may be eligible to borrow under the Federal Stafford Loan program. Students under this exception are eligible to borrow up to \$5000 in subsidized Federal Stafford Loan and, as an independent student, up to \$10000 in unsubsidized Federal Stafford Loan (no more than the student's undergraduate cost of attendance as determined by the Financial Aid Office). The program must be required for initial elementary or secondary teacher certification or re-certification in the state where the student teaches or the state in which the student is completing the program. This exception is not intended to cover optional courses that the student elects to take for professional recognition or advancement. Nor does the exception cover courses that the school recommends but that are not required for certification or recertification. Students taking classes for professional recognition or advancement ARE NOT eligible under these criteria. The undergraduate total loan limits apply to borrowers in this category.
