The JBCSC is designed to provide the learner with the opportunity to practice skills and problem solving in a simulated healthcare environment. The centers maintain the equipment and the resources to facilitate the learner's acquisition of competence with the skills to care for patients in the clinical setting.

Learners in a professional nursing program must function within the legal, moral, and ethical standards of the profession. Therefore, each learner must adhere to the following guidelines for your clinical simulation preparation and performance.

- I. Learners are expected to be on time. Late arrivals will not be allowed to participate and it will be a missed clinical experience.
- II. Learners must show up in clinical dress code. Failure to show up in clinical dress will result in not being allowed to participate and it will be a missed clinical experience.
- III. Required Equipment:
 - a. Mental Health Scenarios: Name badge
 - b. Hospital Scenarios: Stethoscope, penlight, bandage scissors, pen with black ink, and watch with second hand.
